



EARLY YEARS PUPIL PREMIUM

VOLUNTARY REGISTRATION

Dear parent,

From April 2015 all early years providers who deliver Government funded early education will be able to claim the Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) for three and four year old children whose parents are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

NB Children who have left the care of the Local Authority i.e. those who have been adopted, left care through a special guardianship order or are subject to child arrangement orders, will also be eligible to EYPP.

Registering could result in extra funding for your child's early years education

We need information about you and your child, to provide the best education and support by making sure we receive all the government funding to which we and your child are entitled.

Registering could provide up to an extra £300 per child for us to fund valuable support like extra training or, resources to help raise the quality of your child's early education.

We are committed to ensuring that the personal and sensitive information that we hold about you is protected and kept safe and secure, and we have measures in place to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information.

We will use the information you provide to assess entitlement to the early years pupil premium.
