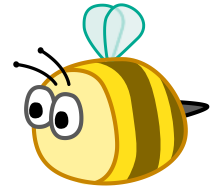
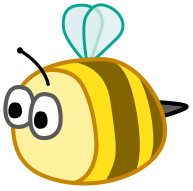


Learning Behaviours

Autumn 1: **Be Ready!**

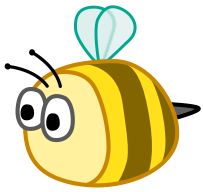
Autumn 2: **Be Respectful!**

Spring 1: **Be Resilient!**

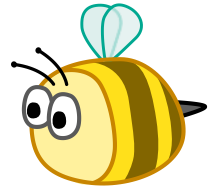
Spring 2: **Be Responsible!**

To Be Ready

- Arrive at school on time
- Show good sitting and listening
- Have a positive attitude
- Be focused on the activity

To Be Responsible

- Look after the resources in the room.
- Work independently and as part of a team.
- Use the internet safely.
- Take ownership for behaviour.

To Be Reflective

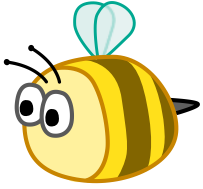
- Edit and improve work.
- Think about what happens in the playground and how to solve it.
- Talk about feelings.
- Listen to others and make an informed decision.

To Be Respectful

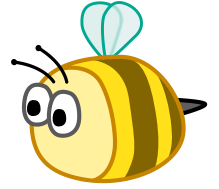
- To say please and thank you.
- To listen to others.
- To wait and not call out.
- To accept that everyone is different.

To Be Resilient

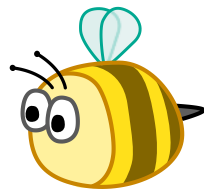
- Try our best at all times.
- Keep trying, even if something is difficult.
- Control emotions.
- Handle disappointment appropriately.



How can you help at home?



- Encourage children to get everything ready for school the night before.
- Play games that help children develop their turn taking and patience skills.
- Go out for the day and then look back at what you have done.
- Provide help with homework, encouraging them to have a go!
- Talk about what makes people happy/sad/etc.
- Set some hard challenges that they really have to work at achieving.
- Give them responsibility around the house—have a go at washing the dishes or doing the hovering.
