Are we like other members of our family?



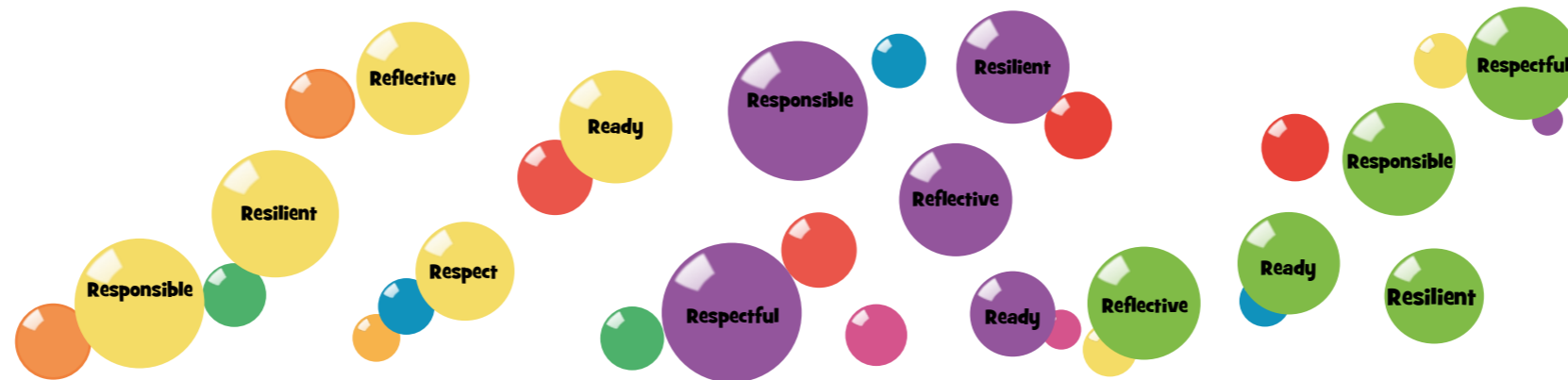
This theme explores the idea of similarities and differences between humans and animals and their off-spring.
