

L Some of us will be following the Read Write Inc Literacy programme to develop our phonic and reading skills. We will write our own play script for a new scene in a play. We will also create an advert for our play.

- We will use mathematical vocabulary to describe position and movement.
- We will be learning about right angles, quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anti-clockwise).
- We will recognise, find, name and write fractions.
- We solve problems involving measures (height, mass, temperature, capacity, money and time).
