L Some of us will be following the Read Write Inc Literacy programme to develop our phonic and reading skills. We will write a fantasy story set in space. We will also write an information text about chocolate and present it to others.

- We will be solving practical problems, especially measures and adding / subtraction.
- We will be learning the value of coins.
- We will also be looking at fractions and division.
- Children will also be learning how to measure and record time using hours/ minutes/ seconds.
- Finally, we will be naming 3D shapes.

S As scientists we learn about exercise and healthy eating. We look again at materials and investigate melting and freezing, changing some materials from solid to liquid and vice-versa.

C We will continue learn how to code and develop our 2D animation using Scratch online software.

MFL Through play, songs, rhymes and games children will learn a range of basic vocabulary in French including numbers, animals, instructions, greetings, families and hobbies. They will also learn about French cultures and traditions.

The Big Question

Where does our food come from?



We compare the physical and human features of Plymouth city to the capital city of Ghana. We explore cocoa production and look at how foods from other countries have influenced our diet, considering whether the foods we choose are healthy or not.

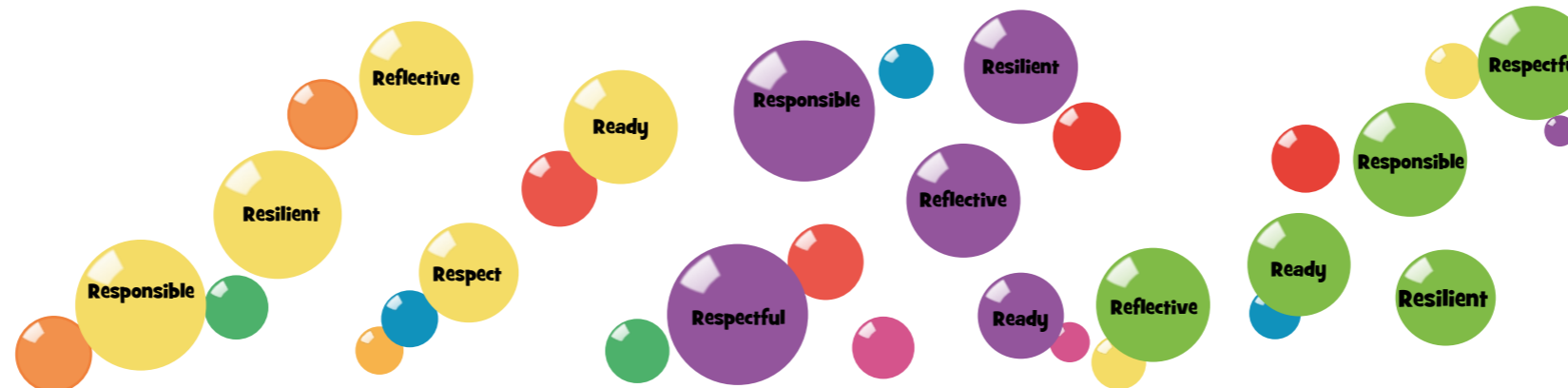
PE During our indoors PE lesson we will be practising our gymnastics skills. We will also create dances based on our literacy focus on fantasy stories about aliens and space.

G We will look at the similarities and differences between the South West Region and Ghana. We will find out about the cocoa producing regions of Africa and learn about the importance of Fair Trade.

PSHE As part of our Health and Wellbeing sessions we will be focusing on how we grow and change, also the transition we go through by moving class and year group.

RE We will look at what it means to people when they are part of a faith community, whether Christian, Jewish, Muslim or a non-religious group. We will look at the ways in which people show their love, express their identity and belonging within these faith communities.

M As musicians we will develop a sense of a steady beat, we will use our bodies and instruments to respond to music and play rhythm patterns. We will interpret a soundboard with sound effects and develop our own interpretation using our voices and percussion.
